**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
MAHACHULALONGKORNRAJAVIDYALAYA UNIVERSITY,
INTERNATIONAL BUDDHIST STUDIES COLLEGE, THAILAND
AND
DONGGUK UNIVERSITY (DGU), COLLEGE OF BUDDHISM (COB), INSTITUTE
FOR BUDDHIST CULTURE, KOREA**



Mahachulalongkornrajavidyalaya University, International Buddhist Studies College (IBSC), Thailand and Dongguk University (DGU), College of Buddhism (COB), Institute for Buddhist Culture (IBC), Korea, agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding, which serves as a statement of the mutual desire of both institutions for academic collaboration in the coming years. This Memorandum is based on the foundation of mutual trust for the benefit and development of the three institutions, the accomplishment of our missions, and the promotion of international understanding and goodwill.

I. It is hereby agreed that the three institutions shall cooperate on the following.

- a) Exchange of students for study and research at both universities
- b) Exchange of professors, scholars, and administrators through mutual visits
- c) Exchange of information and publication on education and research
- d) Implementation of cooperative education and research

II. Implementation

- a) In order to carry out the above-mentioned activities, detailed plans of the academic cooperation, strategies for the interactions, and mechanisms leading to the exchange of students and personnel shall be formed through consultation between the three institutions and expressed in academic agreements.
- b) Three institutions shall agree to seek financial support for the mutually agreed cooperative activities defined in the above from appropriate agencies of their respective government and other agencies.
- c) This Agreement will be effective for five (5) years after the date of signing. This Agreement is renewed automatically as long as neither party gives notice of termination to the other.
- d) The notice of termination of this Agreement needs to be given six (6) months in advance.

III. Cooperative Research and Intellectual Property



Such proposals may be made at any time and an individual project agreement will be drafted for each research project. The protection and exploitation of any valuable intellectual property arising out of a research project will be addressed in each individual project agreement.


